It will be mounted on a suitable sized rock at Jonas Creek Rec Site.
4. Moricetown Trail; is now good to go! Both cleaner and safer. Thank you to Bob, Tina, Doug, Colin, Al, Bruce and Dave for making this a better trail for everyone, job well done. We also looked at the feasibility of making another bridge in this area but decided on clearing a safer route through the creek by removing a few trees some brush and rocks and shoveling down the banks, much, much better and safer.
5. **Telkwa Pass Project:** Dan had a meeting with Joanne and Ben. Joanne is sending him the latest version which Dan and Colin will try to update. For insurance reasons, Dave and Gord have been selected as the two society directors. At present the project has been approved for \$50K capital budget and most of the work to be completed is at the Terrace end. I will sit with Joanne when I receive the information and complete the paper work. We are looking at August to have completed. Will update the club as things change. Thanks Dan!

3. FYI, The deadline for registering your ATV has been extended to November 1st. At this time you will be able to choose between a license plate for your ORV or a decal the size of a license plate. People that have already registered and received a license plate will be able at this time to exchange for a decal if desired instead of plate.
4. Ride Ideas: Volunteers needed to guide groups. If you've got a favorite spot to go guide the club in so we can all enjoy. Pick a week end date and let us know we're always looking for new destinations.

6. Booth at Trade Show for next year? This was discussed and agreed as one avenue to pursue but members felt sticking with an outdoor atv show that could/would evolve into dealer demo rides at a larger location such as the fairgrounds or other would be our better option. We will ask the Interior news if this is how they see this event evolving.
7. Dome Trail is still deteriorating from water erosion. This is a valuable trail to our club and the community due to its accessibility and close proximity to town. Some sections are starting to be hazardous to traverse and may not be suitable for novice riders. We need to schedule a Work Bee to clean up any trees down and GPS areas of concern on the trail. A Ride Date of June 28, 2015 10:00 am at the Dome Parking Lot is scheduled. We will make it both business and pleasure.
Update: **Dome Repairs:** Dan also let Ben know that we had a ride scheduled for June to do repairs to the trail. Capital money is not available at present since they only want one capital project going on at one time per club. (Telkwa Pass) If there is work requiring immediate action on the trails, Ben said that some money might be available. He has asked that we do a report or list and take pictures as to the repairs required for the Dome Trail. They have also extended the grant deadline and Ben suggested that we complete the grant request and have it filed with them ahead of time.
8. Eugene Becker of the Intensive Motorized use group was on hand at the meeting and thanked us for the letter of support for their group.
