Old Business:

1. We have sent away our list of directors to ATV/BC and are now registered as a club on their website, check it out on atv/bc.ca lots of info on this site.
2. Liability insurance renewal application form was completed at the June Meeting and sent into ATV/BC, should be up to date on all forms now.
3. FYI, The deadline for registering your ATV has been extended to November 1st
4. Dome Trail is still deteriorating from water erosion. This is a valuable trail to our club and the community due to its accessibility and close proximity to town. Some sections are starting to be hazardous to traverse and may not be suitable for novice riders. We need to schedule a Work Bee to clean up any trees down and GPS areas of concern on the trail.

Club correspondence:

1. Brian Deacon of the Terrace ATV Club. Came through the Pass with a group of riders June 21st and said that the going was good, very little snow and rode to the snowmobile cabin on our side (Micro-Wave).
2. Hi I was recently quadding up at red rose mine, the trail is pretty overgrown. I and a friend would be interested in brushing out this trail with help. Maybe an organized ride and brushing day? Any thoughts?

New Business:

1. Update from Colin on the Dome Ride. Tentative plans for trail up keep, what do we do next? The members discussed options but all were costly and a big undertaking for our club. The trail is reported to be very rough, with sections that maybe unsafe to inexperienced riders. This area is one of a few that offers a "loop route" for family rides and Poker Runs it would be a shame to let it go. We will continue to consider options.

2. Update Dan and/or Colin on the Telkwa Pass / Jonas Creek Shelter project, what's happening? Dan was on holidays and unable to update, Dave will contact Ben and Conrad and get an update for us.
3. Info on plaque for Lloyd, numerous ideas. Options were looked at and a decision made, we will get a plaque 24" x 24" made of stainless steel with 1" plasma cut lettering in dedication to Lloyd. We need to explore ideas for where / what to mount plaque to. May have to bring in a large stone for the Jonas Creek Rec Site.
4. Sign up List for August 23rd. 20 members can go on Starr Basin Ride. We are following up on a letter of permission from Conrad Thiessen that would allow 20 BV Quad Riders Members access into the Santa Maria Mine Area on Aug 23, 2015. There is a list of 10 stipulations that must be agreed to before permission is granted, those terms were discussed at the meeting and agreed upon. Riders signing up for this outing must also agree to terms, no exceptions. Contact Dave Tolton 250-847-4565 to sign up. We will meet at 8:30 am at the Micro-wave parking area if the ride is a go.
5. Update on permission for Grizzly Mountain Ride will this happen this month. It was previously agreed that we would ask for Grizzly Mountain one year and possibly Starr Basin the following year (not both for one year) as permission may be granted for Starr Basin for 2015 we will hold on Grizzly Mountain till 2016.
6. Poker Ride discussed Aug 8th can we set a date and organize volunteers. Location? Dome?? Other? As above the Dome may not be suitable for our Poker Runs until trail conditions improve. We will for this reason hold a Poker Run August 9th at the Micro-wave. Registration will be at 9:30 am and the run will commence at 10:00 am. Prize money will be \$500 first prize, \$300 second Prize, \$200 third prize. Volunteers are needed for registration and card pick up points call Dave @250-847-4565 to volunteer.
