## ACTIVITY NOTICE RE: BC HYDRO LINE UPGRADES THROUGH TELKWA PASS

There is a major BC Hydro line upgrade being initiated Monday, July 11<sup>th</sup> through the Telkwa Pass. There will be an operational fly yard at approximately 48/49 km. BC Timber Sales has an active license just issued at 48-50 km. The Limonite will be congested.

BC Hydro is hoping their project to be completed in six weeks. My suggestion is to delay any routine business you may have in the area particularly along Branches 500 and 550.
