- Moricetown / Suskwa Trail, talked to Brandy and Joanne about having trail registered. Any old paper work that may have been generated is gone and RSTBC says we have to start from square one again. Will leave for discussion at meeting. We must be careful about what we bite off for this year, our Dome Project may be sufficient. **Not enough present to have a consensus one way or another? RSTBC need to see documentation on why this area / trail is important to club? Why do we want it registered?**
- Have a few tickets still for Provincial ATVBC Raffle \$10 ea. first prize new 850 Can Am or \$13,000.00 cash. Club receives \$10.00 from every book of 10 sold, we took 5 books. **Call Dave for tickets have about 12 left.**
