Correspondence/Old Business:

- Telkwa Pass Project – Lloyd is in the process of partnership with Forestry.
- ATVBC membership: Good presentation and discussion with Jeff Mohr on pros and cons on joining ATVBC. Some of the ideas and suggestions discussed are membership costs - \$40.00 Primary and \$15.00-\$25.00 secondary which means all members of our club would have to be members of the ATVBC. We would have five million liability insurance which would cover volunteers, directors and poker rides. For competitive rides it would cost us \$250.00. You get 25% off bike insurance, 10% if you have had a safety course and 10% if you have a disabler in your bike. ATV trips to other ATVBC functions in the province. At the next meeting we will discuss the ATVBC proposal. Thanks to Jeff for attending.
- Also ICBC will be potentially coming in to play this fall where registration could be up to \$48.00 and you will need a licence plate.
- Moose Skin Johnny (key for gate) – Letter from Conrad. Members felt that there was no support. Too many conditions. Lloyd said he would be talking Conrad about these conditions.
- E-mail from Jeff Mohr – Revised strategic approach to rail trail management by the Ministry of Lands and Natural Resource Operations. Jeff told us that the hikers and cyclists are after ownership on these trails. We would like to see a multi-use policy put in place.
- Club insurance – presently still on hold.
- Interior news quote on IMO: Dan read the letter from the paper and discussed the news article.
